Every Monday | 12-1 PM BHS Castle



Take a Look Back...

Silent screen legend Gloria Swanson (March 27, 1899 – April 4, 1983) appeared in more than 70 films over her career, though she's probably best remembered by modern audiences for her award-winning performance in 1950's "Sunset Boulevard." Swanson's portrayal of a faded silent-film star named Norma Desmond was famously parodied by

Carol Burnett on her 1970s variety show, and the film was later reinvented as a Broadway musical in 1994, with Glenn Close in the title role. Swanson once resided in Bayside, Queens, and was among the stars featured in the Bayside Historical Society's 2016 exhibit, *Bayside: The Actors' Enclave*.
